Of the Euro-Mediterranean Teacher Training Seminar on How to Use the New Developed Material on Religious Diversity Amman, Jordan, 27-29 June 2007

This seminar represents an important step in our programme of developing concrete tools to deal positively with the diversity one may face in his/her everyday teaching experience.

Following the *Final Recommendations* of the Teacher Training Course held in Alexandria, Egypt, 20 – 24 November 2006, on "*How to do Deal with Religious Diversity in Classrooms*" whose details are available on the <u>Multilingual Teaching and Learning Material on Cultural Diversity and Religious Pluralism</u>, the Anna Lindh Foundation has conveyed a multicultural team of experts, and asked them to develop material under the form of teaching units.

June 2007, the Anna Lindh Foundation has gathered teachers and trainers from various cultural, religious and social backgrounds from a sample of the 37 countries of the Euro-Mediterranean partnership in order to present these units, test their validity and find together a way of making them perfectly suitable to our aims and needs.

Units have been developed and cover topics ranging from family, clothing, death and birth, worship, language, peace and war related issues, etc. trying to find commonalities instead of differences between faiths and cultures in order to build areas of better understanding.

Our expert team was composed of teachers and teaching units designers from Europe and the Mediterranean.
