

Summary of Project

According to the Eurostat statistics youth unemployment rate in Europe in July 2014 was 21.7 % in the EU-28. This is the lowest rate for the EU-28 since September 2011, but anyway the rate is still high as the latest statistics of Eurostat december 2016 shows 18.6 % of young people are unemployed in the EU-28. The highest rates were observed in , Greece (46.13%), Spain (43.6 %)Italy (36.4 %), Croatia (29.7%).

Entrepreneurship is one the most important aspect to fight with youth unemployment as today social entrepreneurship is becoming one of the effective and innovative methods to solve the social problems. It gives the opportunity to deal with the problematic issue in a creative way that in turn helps to involve into social sphere more people, create alternative jobs and income. In light of economic changes, globalization and requirements on labor market (the moving from employment to employability) entrepreneurship itself is becoming popular issue among young people as a lot of them are struggling to find job or having their own income. As a result of these young people are searching alternative way which turns to be running of their own enterprises. In order to be able to do this they need some certain skills and knowledge like knowledge business sector, understanding financial risk and management, having soft skills (communication, leadership, management etc). Moreover, 90 % of all startups are failing which stops young people to put their ideas in action. At this point NGOs should provide young people with information and help on the topic of social entrepreneurship and involve them into the issue. But there are not many organizations which are competitive enough in this field.

That youth exchange “A new Job - A new Love - Entrepreneurship” aims to develop participants’ skills on social entrepreneurship, financial management, creativity, soft skills, strategic planning of the ideas. It is designed for youth leaders, youth volunteers ages between 18 - 30 to explore methods of working with youth on the topic of social entrepreneurship and practical skills on running the social enterprise with their organizations. The priority age group will be 18 - 30 years old. The whole project is built up and developed in accordance with the objectives and the priorities of the Erasmus+ Programme.

Our objectives are:

- 1) To develop creative thinking, soft skills, financial management, strategic planning of the ideas and social entrepreneurship skills
- 2) To transfer knowledge and experiences on how to motivate young people in developing entrepreneurial paths.
- 3) To offer a basic exchange on how to develop, validate and implement social entrepreneurial projects.
- 4) To explore practical ways of supporting young people set up social enterprises, taking into consideration legal, financial, management and social requirements.
- 5) To equip youth leaders and youth volunteers with tools and methods designed to develop entrepreneurial skills
- 6) To develop new methods and tools of working on the topic of social entrepreneurship.
- 7) To provide participants with the opportunity to exchange experience and expertise in the field of social entrepreneurship.
- 8) To inform the participants about opportunities to develop new projects under the Erasmus+ Programme.

New Job, New Love, Entrepreneurship

The project will be take place in Konya between April 9th to 18th 2018 and It will gather together 37 participants from programme countries such as Czech Republic, Italy, Spain, Slovenia, Lithuania, Romania and Turkey. Working methodologies of the youth exchange will be based the non-formal education methods such as outdoor activities, debates, discussions, sharing experiences, creative sessions and self-assessment sessions, role-play activities, simulation games, meetings with young entrepreneurs, Erasmus+ possibilities, innovative presentations, team-building activities, energisers, ice-breakers, "getting to know each other" tools, brainstorms, individual/pair/group work, inspirational visit, feedback and reflection sessions. Regarding to the specific methods and tools on the project topic the facilitators will use business model canvas, creativity tools, brainstorm maps, logical framework, problem tree , etc. Except the facilitators, local and international young social entrepreneurs and experts will involve into the project.

The main results of the project will be activities for young people on the topic of social entrepreneurship implemented by project participants in the countries and social enterprises created by young people after these activities. We expect that the youth exchange will help the organizations to start to run their own social enterprises. Also the project will increase the quality of youth activities and projects on local and international levels, including new cooperation.

Profile of Participants and Working Language

Profile of participants: Youngsters aged between 18-30, who are interested in the topics of social entrepreneurship, entrepreneurship. Please look at table below to see how many participants are needed for each country.

Language: The language youth exchange will be English. **English Fluency is not a must.**

Working Methodologies

Youth exchange will be based on non-formal education methods such as group works, simulations, individual reflections, peer to peer learning etc. It means that learning is based on your experience, your motivation and your needs. You are not only responsible for your learning but the all team.

Responsibility of Partner Organizations

- Finding motivated and experienced participants
- to assist travel arrangements
- to warn the participants about the travel documents for reimbursement.

Preparation for the Youth Exchange

Participants will need to cooperate with participants from same country by; Each country group will make a research on **social entrepreneurship**. in their communities and will prepare a presentation up to 15 minutes. Presentations will include interviews with locals, study work of NGOs, social enterprises, numbers and statistics.

Presentation of organization: participants will prepare a presentation of their organization and will bring materials such brochures, fliers, posters, etc.

Research on best practices: Country groups will make research on eco-system of social entrepreneurship in their country. Please bring the documentation of this activities (photos, videos, articles)

Learning goals; You need to prepare individually; Your own learning goals for the project, your contribution to project.

Intercultural Night; For intercultural night please bring food, drinks, and snacks to present during intercultural night. You can also show dance, play music etc. There will be no power point presentation as it will be only sharing caring time to spend together.

Financial Issues and Conditions

Reimbursement will be done in July 2018, hopefully the first week of the month but the latest until the end of July. Reimbursement will be made via bank transfer which will not cost you extra fee as we will do it from an European Bank.

!!! Note (IMPORTANT): We will NOT REFUND any tickets that have been purchased by a travel agency, as it is not the most cost effective method, it will NOT be refunded!

!!! Note: Reimbursement of travel costs will only be done upon presentation of all (including return tickets) original tickets, receipt/invoices and boarding passes. Please print before all documents, which are related to travel expenses. This means that after the exchange, participants will be asked to send the originals of all return documents and boarding passes. Please remember to **bring the original invoices** there will be no reimbursement without the original invoices and tickets with indicated names of travelers, description of the journey, indication of cost and currency and date of travel.

Please do not lose your boarding passes; you will need them for reimbursement of travel cost.

!!! Note: If participants pay for their ticket with a credit card, they are requested to bring along the confirmation of payment (i.e. credit card slip and/or bank statement).

!!! Note: Reimbursement will be done in Euros, regardless of the currency indicated on the ticket and receipt/invoice. Any tickets purchased in a local currency other than EUR, will then be converted and calculated according to the exchange rate of the month when the grant agreement for this project will be signed by the NA, as stated in the official European Commission web-site at


Accommodation and food & beverages;

Introducing the Konya

Konya, was known in classical antiquity and during the medieval period as Ἰκόνιον (Ikónion) in Greek (with regular Medieval Greek apheresis Kónio(n)) and as Iconium in Latin. This name is commonly explained as a derivation from εἰκών (eikon), as an ancient Greek legend ascribed its name to the "eikon" (image), or the "gorgon's (Medusa's) head", with which Perseus vanquished the native population before founding the city. In some historic English texts, the city's name appears as Konia or Koniah.
